

Wells Pretest Probability for DVT

Clinical Feature

| <input type="checkbox"/> Active cancer (treatment ongoing, within previous 6 months, or palliative) | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Paralysis, paresis, or recent plaster immobilization of the lower extremities | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Recently bedridden for > 3 days or major surgery within 4 weeks | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Localized tenderness along the distribution of the <u>DEEP</u> venous system | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <u>Entire</u> leg swollen | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Calf swelling > 3 cm when compared with the asymptomatic leg* | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <u>Pitting</u> edema (greater in the symptomatic leg) | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Collateral superficial veins (non-varicose) | 1 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <u>Alternative</u> diagnoses as likely as or greater than that of DVT | -2 |

* Measured 10 cm below tibial tuberosity

In patients with symptoms in both legs, the more symptomatic leg should be used.

High pretest probability	≥3 points
Moderate pretest probability	1-2 points
Low pretest probability	zero or negative points

| <input type="checkbox"/> An alternate diagnosis is less likely than PE | 3.0 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Heart Rate > 100 beats/min | 1.5 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Immobilization or surgery in the previous 4 wks | 1.5 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Previous DVT/PE | 1.5 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Hemoptysis | 1.0 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Malignancy (on treatment, treated in past 6 mo, or palliative) | 1.0 |

| High pretest probability | >6 points |
| Moderate pretest probability | 2-6 points |
